His work demonstrates how social, economic and environmental value is created by the movement, interaction and transaction of people in space.**

Tim advises public, private and community organisations worldwide. His approach combines robust analysis and visionary thinking.

Tim is Managing Director of the strategic consulting firm Space Syntax Limited, which he founded in 1996. He is a Visiting Professor at University College London, a director of The Academy of Urbanism, a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts and a winner of the Harvard Loeb Fellowship. He has recently assisted the UK Government Office for Science as a member of the Lead Expert Group in its Foresight project on The Future of Cities.

In 2016 he gained the Freedom of the City of London and in the same year he was awarded the Changchun Friendship Award for his contribution to the urban planning of the city.
